Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing just 4 individuals. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other components. Throughout five years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is one of the top global makers within the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. All through the last 60 years, the trade of material handling has grown into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade currently continues to develop as the best provider of forklift attachments and various related products. The company feels certain in their ability so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and advertising hydraulic attachments. Construction was done in the year 1956 on a new office in order to house all of the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty employees and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the business recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are made globally due to a lot of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 companies, along with the global best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
