Aerial Work Platforms - There are a variety of lift truck attachments available on the market. They can help transform your forklift so that you can expand your ability to pick objects up or accomplish clean up jobs and material handling with less effort.

Many of the accessories are specifically designed to be able to fit on the forks themselves. Fork extensions for example, are used whenever you need more fork length, which increases lifting capability. Blade extensions come in lengths ranging from forty eight to one hundred twenty inches. Triangular or rounded attachments are one more kind used if moving rolled material so as to make sure it does not roll off of the traditional flat forks.

Examples of lifting attachments include pivoting and telescoping crane or boom attachments. They could come in quite a few various styles and are usually meant for transferring lumber, poles, metal bars and different sort of bulky stuff. Additional attachments like for example various kinds of hook plates and hooks are accessible to carry stuff with a sling or chain. Slab lifters and magnetic lifters are other items which can be utilized together with hook attachments. Slab lifters are specialized accessories that are meant for lifting different materials which are delivered in a sheet or slab format. Carpet poles and rug rams are other lifting tools which attach to your forklift to make moving rolls of carpet easier. The accessory hooks onto the lift truck's blades and has a pole that goes through the middle of the carpet roll.

There are numerous different types of forklift attachments that can be used for facility maintenance like for instance snow blades. These blades connect to front end loaders and can transport materials like for instance soil, snow and dirt. Other common cleanup attachments include standard sweepers and magnetic sweepers. Standard sweepers includes a broom that the forklift forks hook onto for sweeping big spaces like for instance warehouse, factory floors and parking lots. The magnetic sweeper is the same except that it has a magnetic plate instead of bristles. The magnetic sweeper is utilized in places where there is lots of metal fragments such as on shop floors for example. Sweepers have widths up to 60 inches and this surface area makes clean up quick and effortless.

Material spreaders are other accessories utilized on lift trucks. These spreaders are helpful for a variety of applications such as spreading fertilizers, insecticides, seeds, ice melt, rock salt and pellets.

Work platforms are another optional lifting attachment that many companies use daily. The platforms range in size from 36" x 36" to up to 60" x 60". There are a few units available which are capable of folding up and storing into a smaller space. Work platforms are designed to raise staff up to an overhead location utilizing the lift truck. Larger platform models have added space for personnel to be able to bring tools and other essential objects meant for the job. Often work platforms are made of poly material or steel.
